1. Sets 3.0

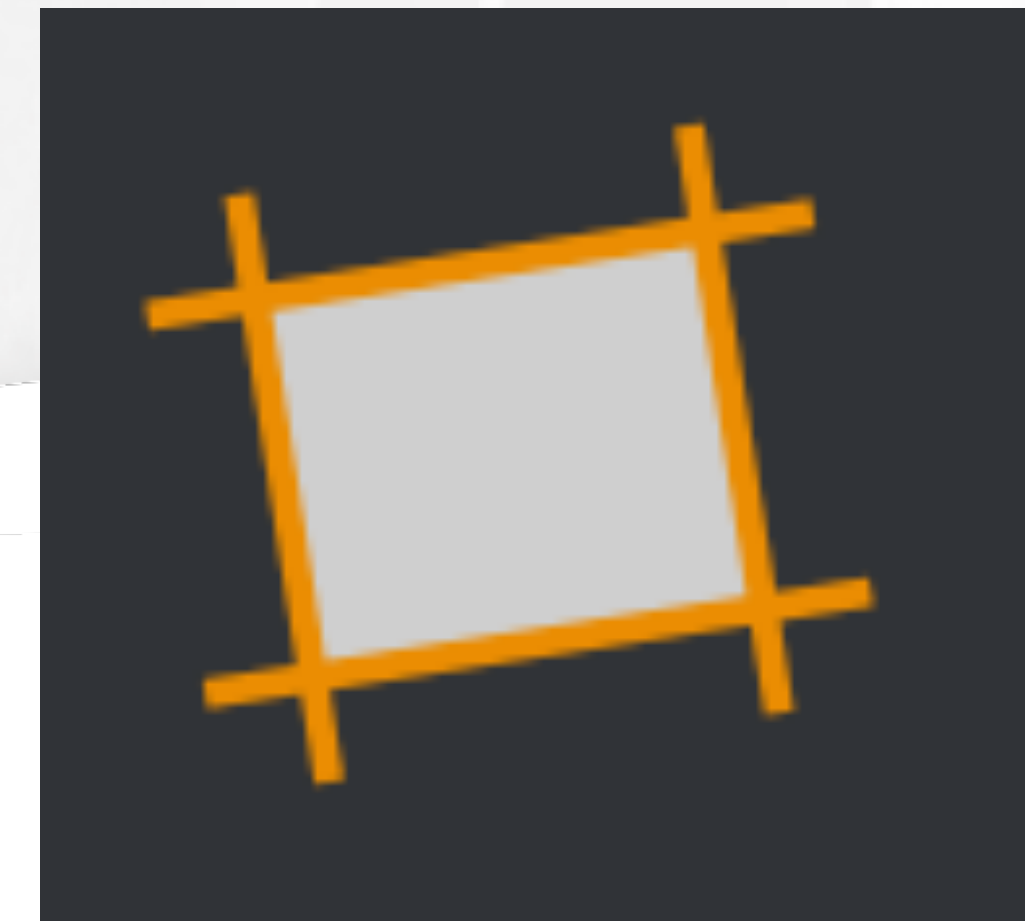
Sets is the feature that lets you view, access and navigate an unlimited number of various source files as a single document in a single tab, just got a whole lot smarter. Files within a Set can now be automatically organized by categories based on preconfigured or custom templates.



2. Sketch and Markup Tools

Quickly create polygons, polylines, rectangles and ellipses based on a PDF calibrated scale.

AKA: Draw to scale.



3. Smarter export to Excel and Word

Export tables to Excel and documents to Word. Choose the entire document or just a area of the PDF.



4.0 Batch Slip Sheet (Extreme)

Your current slip-sheeting method has officially been revised. Batch Slip Sheet automatically matches new revisions with their corresponding current sheets and carries over all markups, hyperlinks, Spaces and bookmarks -- all while stamping superseded sheets. Keeping your complex file sets up to date has never been easier.



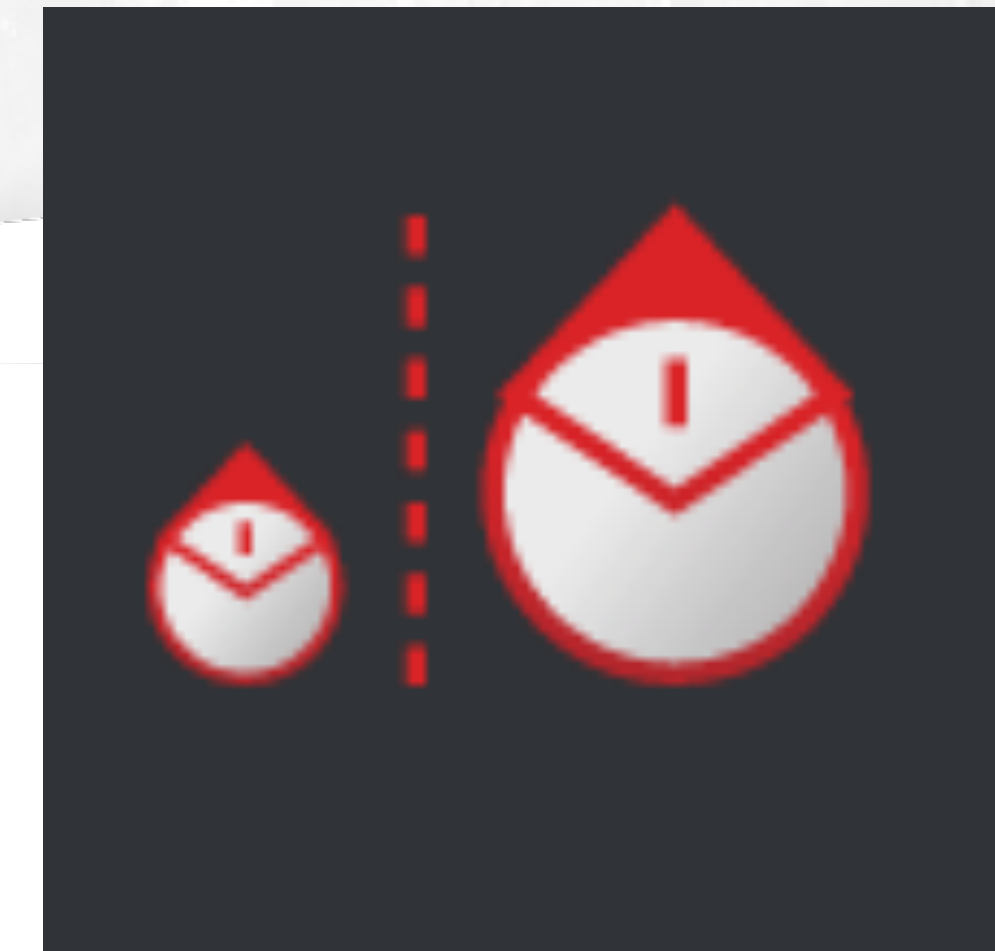
5. Capture 2.0

- Embed photos or videos into any markup using Revu's camera tool, as well as image files.



6. Dynamic Toolset Scaler

Automatically resize markups when used on documents with different scales or different viewport scales.



7. Spaces Enhancements

Spaces allow you to organize your markups by location. Now you can copy and paste spaces from one file to another. You can also get the Area from a space and create a hyperlink from within the space.



8. Studio Enhancements

Share Studio Project files via password protected links, set Studio Session expiration dates and update project files while your work with them in studio. You can also assign permissions based on folder.
